

A special meeting of the Village of Walton Board of Trustees was held on March 30, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. in the Village Hall, 21 North Street, Walton, NY.

Mayor Condon called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**PUBLIC HEARING LOCAL LAW 3-2020** Trustee Ball made a motion to open a Public Hearing on Local Law 3-2020, OVERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT. Trustee Jamieson seconded. Carried unanimously.

The purpose of passing the local law is to allow the Board, if needed, to pass a budget that exceeds the 1.78% (not 2%) allowable tax limit that is set for this year.

Trustee Jamieson made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Trustee Ball seconded. Carried unanimously.

Trustee Sehen made a motion to pass Local Law 3-2020 to Override the Tax Levy Limit for the 2020-2021 Budget Year. Trustee Jamieson seconded. Carried unanimously.

**PUBLIC HEARING 2020-2021 PROPOSED BUDGET** Trustee Sehen made a motion to open the Public Hearing on the 2020-2021 Proposed Budget. Trustee Ball seconded. Carried unanimously.

The 2020-2021 Proposed Budget was submitted to the Board which reflects a 1.78% tax rate increase. There has been a couple last minute salary rate increase requests. The Board will take no action at this time so they can crunch some numbers to see the impact and address at the meeting on April 6<sup>th</sup>. Copy attached.

Trustee Sehen made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Trustee Jamieson seconded. Carried unanimously.

**ABSTRACTS:** The audit committee reviewed the abstracts and recommended approval as follows:

The General Fund Abstract in the sum of \$69,735.88 was presented to the Board.

The Water Fund Abstract in the sum of \$4,385.18 was presented to the Board.

The Sewer Fund Abstract in the sum of \$128,437.03 was presented to the Board.

After review, Trustee Sehen made a motion to approve the abstracts as submitted. Trustee Ball seconded. Carried unanimously.

**PROVISIONAL SERGEANT APPOINTMENT** Chief D'Addezio recommended Officer Dunphy as Provisional Sergeant. Trustee Ball made a motion to appoint Officer Devin Dunphy as Provisional Sergeant effective April 6<sup>th</sup> at the negotiated PBA rate. Trustee Sehen seconded. Carried unanimously.

**Local Law No. 3 of the year 2020**

**Village of Walton County of Delaware**

**A LOCAL LAW  
TO OVERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT  
ESTABLISHED IN GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW 3-C**

**Section 1: Legislative intent.**

It is the intent of this local law to allow the Village of Walton to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2020, that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the “tax levy limit” as defined by General Municipal Law 3-c.

**Section 2: Authority**

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law 3-c, which expressly authorizes a local government’s governing body to override the property tax cap for the coming fiscal year by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty (60%) of said governing body.

**Section 3: Tax Levy Limit Override**

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Walton, County of Delaware, is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2014, that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed in General Municipal Law 3-c.

**Section 4: Severability**

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court’s order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

**Section 5. Effective date.**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
