

The regular meeting of the Walton Village Board was held on Monday, May 27, 2021 at 3:00 p.m. in the Village Hall, 21 North Street, Walton.

Mayor Snow called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**ABSTRACTS:** The audit committee reviewed the abstracts and recommended approval as follows:  
The General Fund Abstract in the sum of \$30,303.76 was presented to the Board.  
The Water Fund Abstract in the sum of \$1,344.73 was presented to the Board.  
The Sewer Fund Abstract in the sum of \$127,619.07 was presented to the Board.  
The Trust & Agency Abstract in the sum of \$1,744.20 was presented to the Board.  
The Shepard St. Capital Fund Abstract in the sum of \$503.91 was presented to the Board.  
After review, Trustee Jamieson made a motion to approve the abstracts as submitted. Trustee Doig seconded. Carried unanimously.

**TRUSTEE REPORTS** Trustee Doig brought an annual agreement for the Village to review regarding the recreation program and the Veterans' Plaza water bill to discuss at the June meeting.  
The new Police vehicle is now in service and it is marked. Trustee Doig recommended moving the Durango to the Shop as the new staff vehicle and maybe the Impala could be used by Code Enforcement. The Ford to be used as the second Police vehicle.

Trustee Jamieson mentioned that lifeguards are needed and a class is scheduled for the end of June if anyone is interested. An Arts & Crafts leader is also needed.

Trustee Ball mentioned that there are more store fronts opening on Delaware St.
