

A special meeting of the Village of Walton Board of Trustees was held on March 30, 2022 at 3:30 p.m. in the Village Hall, 21 North Street, Walton, NY.

Mayor Snow called the meeting to order at 3:44 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

BUDGET WORKSHOP The water rates were discussed for the Public Hearing on April 4th. The rate of \$6.15 per 1,000 gallons will only raise \$11,600.00 on the projected sale of 58,000,000 gallons of water. The Board agreed that the increase is needed.

Trustee Jamieson made a motion to levy the unpaid water and sewer balances to the 2022-2023 tax bills. Trustee Doig seconded. Carried unanimously.

A price increase notice was received this past week for a chemical to treat the wastewater at the WWTP. The increase was \$.60 per gallon and projected cost increase is \$45,375.00. Trustee Doig made a motion to submit a revision of the 2022-2023 NYC DEP by \$45,375.00 for G8130.519. Trustee Ball seconded. Carried unanimously.

After review of the submitted budget, Trustee Ball made a motion to hold the Public Hearing on the 2022-2023 Tentative Budget on April 13th at 6:00 p.m. Trustee Jamieson seconded. Carried unanimously.

SHEPARD ST. STREET LIGHT The streetlight was discussed again for 47 Shepard St. Mayor Snow and Trustee Doig have both observed the location under varies weather conditions and during the night. It is their feeling that it is a driveway issue and not a street light issue. Trustee Doig, Trustee Jamieson, and Trustee Ball all agreed that no action would be taken on the matter and Trustee Doig would draft a letter to Mr. Hults.

MEETING ADJOURNED Mayor Snow adjourned the meeting at 4:23 p.m.
